

Sageducation Home Page

When you first visit the page you will see a list of Available Courses that are open to the public.

These courses provide samples of our standard Lesson material and Overviews.

Most of our courses, however, require that you create an account and then find a course you'd like to take. If you find a course you would like to take, please use the **Request a Course** form..

If you are a registered user, when you log in, you'll see your **'Dashboard** page which will display only the courses you are enrolled in. NOTE that the front page course lists change as we publish more courses, but the layout features are the same.

1. Login or Create an Account: Click here to log in or create a new account. Once you have logged in you will see your userid icon and a link to a dropdown with options to view and update your profile.

2. Logo: Click on either of these logos to return to the home page.

3. Introduction: Tells you a bit about our site

4. Available Courses: These are our 'open' courses for which there is no login required

5. Course Categories: This list provides a list of all available categories of courses: you can either expand each by clicking on the small arrow to the left of the title or click on the 'Expand all' option to the right to see all the courses within all categories

6. Blocks: This is a list of tools and resources. The ones listed here are the standard front page blocks. You can expand or collapse the blocks using the "+" or "-" icons in the block title bar.

7. Quickstart Guide: This handout guides you through our site.

8. Minimized Block: This block is minimized so that the content is hidden. To see the content (as with the other blocks) click on the small "+" sign in the block header.

Your “Dashboard” Page

Once you have logged in to sageducation, you can access your ‘**Dashboard**’ page from your profile link in the upper left of the page or as the first link in the Navigation block on all pages. This page displays only courses in which you are enrolled and also permits you to customize how the page looks.

1. **User Account Link:** Link to the dropdown which provides link to your user tools
2. **Course List:** A list of all courses in which you are enrolled.
3. **Progress Donuts:** These donuts provide a graphic indication of your progress through the course (orange area)
4. **Sageducation Quick Start Guide:** Link to this guide, available on all pages.
5. **User bookmarks:** This block appears on all pages so that you can bookmark any page on the site. This user has bookmarked Responsive Behaviours for Health Care Professionals.
6. **Navigation block:** You can expand the block by clicking on the “+” and you can use it to navigate throughout the entire site.
7. **Site Home:** Clicking on the sageducation logos will bring you to your Dashboard page. If you want to get to the actual sageducation home page, click on this link to the **Site Home**.
8. **Viewing Lesson Modules:** This block provides links to instructions on how to enable Pop-up windows (for our Course modules) and instructions and download for installing the Adobe Flash Player.

- 5. Block Customization Options:** The block Configure dropdown options.
